Is your school partnership interested in projects with a global dimension? Would teacher visits help you plan joint curricular activities?

Grants are available to partnerships between schools in the UK and schools in an eligible Southern country that are working together to embed a global dimension in their curricula.

Grants are awarded to school partnerships that have:

- Strong global dimension education goals
- Equity-based relationships
- Sustainable aims.

Reciprocal Visit grants are for young partnerships. They enable teachers from each school to visit their partner school to plan joint curricular work with a global dimension.
