**A NEW TEACHERS PROJECT**, enabling research and development of FAIR TRADE citizenship activities in schools, is starting soon.

### **"GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP IN SCHOOLS FOCUSED ON FAIR TRADE"**

The project will be run by the **Montgomery Development Education Centre** with full support from **Aberdeen Learning and Leisure Services**. Initial funding from **Oxfam** will allow the project to run from 4/04 – 3/05. It is hoped to find funding to continue the work for a second year.

**Each teacher taking part in the project will receive in the first year**

- a **package of resources for their school** including a teachers' research guide, global citizenship teaching packs and a selection of classroom packs linking FAIR TRADE to Environmental Studies and class topics
- **payment to allow supply cover for 2 days** to give time for the research and development aspects for the project
- **two twilight trainings** involving sessions on developing the best method of research for your school, using the resources from the pack in the classroom, planning your fair trade activities and linking these to local, national and global initiatives.
- **full support throughout the project from staff at the Montgomery Development Education Centre**
